- out of the 97 veterinary universities in Europe, the University of Veterinary Medicine Budapest was the 9th that received the European accreditation
- Hungary is a full member of the European Union. The degree received at the University of Veterinary Medicine,
 Budapest is accepted automatically by the member countries of the Union and in several countries of the world
- centrally located campus, easily accessible by public transport.
- the program takes five and a half years, parallel to the standard curriculum found in most European veterinary programs

ADMISSION

What do you need to apply to the University of Veterinary Medicine Budapest?

- application form
- high school leaving certificate
- Curriculum Vitae (resume)
- short medical report
- copy of passport with your personal data
- three passport size photos
- letters of recommendation can be enclosed

What is the entrance exam look like?

FINANCES AND SERVICE PACKAGES

Application fee: 200 EURO

Exam fee: 250 EURO

Tuition fee: 6 780 EURO (first semester) + 4 200 EURO (second semester) = 10 980 EURO (total/year)

(The deposit of 800 EURO is payable two weeks after acceptance. It is part of the first semester's tuition fee and is non-refundable.)

SERVICE PACKAGE 1:

- Help with the doctor, bank and public transport: students get help with using their medical insurance which they
 get when they arrive to Hungary. Also with opening a bank account and learning how to use the very well-functioning public transport in Budapest. The package also includes the public transport ticket.
- Doctor: students can turn to our doctor at the university weekly if there is something they need to get checked.
- Help with visa and residence permit: students get help with all immigration office matters (including visa and residence permit issues).
- 24/7 hotline: students get a 'safety net' hotline number where our colleague can help them with daily issues if they need it.
- Orientation at the university: students get help from the English Secretariat in every matter related to studies at the university in September. A tour at the campus and an orientation session is also part of the service.
- Sightseeing in Budapest: At the beginning of their studies, students can take part in a sightseeing tour in Budapest with a professional guide.

SERVICE PACKAGE 2:

ALL of the services in PACKAGE 1, plus:
